What does that mean?

A guide to common questions about admissions requirements

PRIOR EDUCATION

Prospective students must have a bachelor's degree in communication design or industrial design from an accredited educational institution and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher out of 4.0.

ESSAY REQUIREMENTS

Your Statement of Educational and Career Goals should be roughly 500 words. It should also include your assessment of how advanced work in design methods will help meet these goals.

TRANSCRIPTS

To be accepted, transcripts must indicate degrees awarded, course titles, credit hours and grades earned for all undergraduate and graduate schools you've attended.

All transcripts must be original, official transcripts, or be certified as "true copies." This means they must bear an original signature and seal, either of the issuing institution or of a notary public. They must have been issued within a year of the application date. Personal copies, while helpful in our preliminary evaluation, are not acceptable for admission.

If you have attended IIT, we can obtain transcripts with notification from you.

TEST SCORES

Prospective Master of Design applicants who do not have a bachelor's in design from an accredited, English speaking university are required to submit GRE scores. All applicants for the MDes/ MBA program must submit GMAT scores regardless of degree background.

FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The TOEFL requirement is waived for applicants who have a degree from an accredited, English-speaking university. If you have not earned a degree from an accredited, English-speaking university, your TOEFL score must be at least 600 PBT, 250 CBT, or 100 IBT.

Also, all international applicants must complete the financial affidavit on page 13. Then, have it certified and return it with your application in order to issue your I-20 or DS-2019 if accepted.

Lastly, all transcripts must be translated into English and certified by a consular official or person authorized to translate documents. To be accepted, all transcripts must have the translator's original signature and an unbroken seal.

APPLICATION FEE

IIT cannot process applications without payment of the \$75 application fee. You may send a personal check, cashiers check or money order made payable to IIT. Money orders can be obtained at local banks and post offices. Do not send cash!

The fee is non-refundable and is not applied toward tuition charges.

International Student Financial Affidavit of Support

For All **International** Applicants

This form is required of all international applicants, before an immigration form (I-20 or IAP-66) can be issued.

U.S. visa regulations require that all F or J visa holders must provide certification of evidence that they will have adequate funds to meet expenses involved in a proposed program of study.

All three sections of this affidavit of support for the first year must have original or certified signatures. Section 3 must also bear the seal and signature of a governmental or bank official, or a seal and signature on a bank statement of account attached to the affidavit and stating that the U.S. specified dollar amount can be transferred.

An I-20 or IAP-66 (DS2019) cannot be issued until an acceptable International Student Financial Affidavit of Support and certification has been received by IIT's Graduate Admission Office.

The following estimates indicate the minimum time required to complete a specific degree program, providing there are no deficiencies and that no prerequisites must be met. There are two semesters in each academic year. If an English course is required, it will be concurrent with other academic courses in a full-time program, but the duration of a Master's program may be extended by one semester or a summer session beyond the normal period of time.
